

2020-2021 Covid-19 Procedures (updated 11/10/20)

- All spectators are required to wear a mask, this is mandatory and will be strictly enforced. Players are not required to wear a mask while playing, however all players will be required to wear a mask while sitting on the bench. The officials will not put the ball in play until all players on the bench are wearing a mask.
- Any player that is not a member of the current team playing will not be allowed to sit on the bench.
- The head coach for each team will not be required to wear a mask while coaching, ALL OTHER COACHES ON THE BENCH WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK.
- All players and coaches who are not actively participating in a game are required to wear a mask at all times.
- Our mask mandate will be strictly enforced, any violators may be asked to leave.
- Spectators are limited to 2 per athlete. This will not include coaches. This will be coordinated with coaches prior to the event.
- All spectators, coaches, officials, players, and tournament staff will have their temperature taken at the door. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 will not be allowed inside the facility.
- If you are sick or someone in your circle of friends or family are sick-stay home!
- Individuals that are "at risk" need to stay home.
- Please keep social distancing in mind at all times. Families may sit together.
- The bleachers will be marked on each court for the "home" and "away" team. Please sit in your designated area. IF YOUR TEAM IS NOT PLAYING YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SIT IN THE BLEACHERS. Additionally, bleachers will me marked to allow for social distancing. Please only sit in designated areas.
- Games will now be scheduled every hour, this extra time will allow fans to transition in and out of the facility.
- Games will be scheduled back to back when possible, moving to start times every hour will allow 10-15 minutes between games for teams to recover.
- Effective immediately games will not start early under any circumstances. Please do not show up more than 15 minutes prior to your game time.
- If your team is not playing please do not crowd the bleachers or baseline area, we should have ample time after each game for them to clear out.
- Once your team's game is over please leave the facility ASAP and return later.
- There will be no handshakes after games.
- Teams will not be allowed to share water bottles; all individuals will be responsible for bringing their own.



- Sports balls will be wiped down before each game, during time outs, at halftime, and after each game.
- Each team will be responsible for their own warmup balls, which should be sanitized throughout the day.
- The concession area will be open, however moving forward we are asking that all food be eaten in the concession area only. We ask that only drinks be consumed in the bleachers.
- Please limit gathering inside the facility. Team meetings can take place outside as weather permits or in lower foot traffic areas of the facility.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available throughout the whole facility. Please use as much as you would like.
- We will have a uniformed security officer in the facility to monitor compliance and ensure that these rules are followed. Anyone not following these rules will be asked to leave and not return.
- All 515 hoops staff members are screened with questions about travel, health, temperature, and contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
